

Capacity: Currently CQEL can collect data for about 17 early learning programs per week, depending on program size.

Experience in ECE: The data collection teams' experience ranges from 4 to 37 years in the early childhood education field.

Sample of CQEL data collection team requirements:

- Bachelor's degree or higher in Early Childhood or related field
- Minimum of 1-2 years experience in an early learning environment
- Ability and experience working with people of various racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic backgrounds
- Reach and maintain reliability on all assigned measures as determined by regular reliability checks
- Knowledge of and experience with child assessments and program assessments

CQEL data collectors are reliable in a variety of measures including: Infant CLASS, Toddler CLASS, Pre-K CLASS, Combined CLASS, ECERS-R, ITERS-R, and FCCERS-R.
