


Cumulative Participation (Actuals vs. Targets)




Key Takeaways:


- Across all provider types, total participation is 87% of RTT-ELC targets.
- 2,167 licensed providers (Centers and Family Homes) are participating in Early Achievers as of May 31, or 93% of the RTT Target of 2,323 providers.
- Of the 70 Head Start & ECEAP Grantees in Washington, 18 are currently participating in EA.

Cumulative Participation (Actuals vs. Targets) - By Facility Type


HS/ECEAP Level 3-5 Participation




Child Care Centers Level 2-5 Participation


Key Takeaways:

- Statewide implementation reached July 1, 2013.
- WA State has 2,167 licensed providers in Early Achievers (39.9% of licensed providers in the state), close to the 42.7% statewide participation target.
- Early Achievers participation is at or close to the statewide target of 42.7% for some of the most populated counties in the state:
 - King (43.0%)
 - Yakima (41.2%)
 - Spokane (42.9%)
 - Clark (43.0%)

Level 3-5 Targets and Actuals: Licensed Providers



Key Takeaways:

- 121 licensed providers have received a quality rating of 3-5 through May 2014.
- Compares to RTT target of 476 (25.4% of target).
- There has been a notable uptick in rating activity in early 2014.
- 248 providers have completed all of the EA requirements for rating and are eligible to be rated at any time which suggests that the upward trend is likely to continue in the coming months.
