**SOLE SOURCE POSTING**

The Department of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF) contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Third Sector Intelligence, Inc. to build upon previous data modeling and analysis to support development and build capacity of DCYF's new Office of Innovation, Alignment, & Accountability (OIAA) to optimize staff experience and expertise while achieving greater transparency and productivity in OIAA analytics and reporting.

Third Sector Intelligence, Inc. has technical expertise that is necessary to fulfill this work which will eliminate resources expended on their learning curve and will allow for work to begin immediately. Many of these projects are already underway so this contractor is knowledgeable about their intent and scope and will be able to move them seamlessly forward from their current status. This will save time and resources. Additionally, this contract includes training for DCYF staff which will reduce future expenditures for contracted work.

The contract will be issued on or about July 16, 2018 through June 30, 2019. The dollar value is estimated at \$950,000.

Offerors contemplating the above requirements are required to submit capability statements detailing their ability to meet the state's requirements by July 9, 2018. The following information should be included in the capability statements: Knowledge of DEL project tools and Professional Development System, MERIT, Learning Management System, training capability by August 2017, knowledge of federal Child Care Development Block Grant requirements, list of previously developed training that meet the Child Care Development Block Grant requirements.

In the absence of other qualified sources, it is the state's intent to make a sole source award of the contract.
